


## Step 1

Are you using the **LibreLink** app on your phone to scan your Libre sensor?

- YES – go to step 5
- NO – go to step 2



## Step 2

Have you set up a **LibreView** account?

- YES – go to step 4
- NO – go to step 3

## Step 3 Setting up a LibreView account

- Go to [www.libreview.com](http://www.libreview.com)
- Click the sign up button **(A)**
- Select 'LibreView Account' **(B)**
- Follow the on-screen instructions regarding country of residence, accepting the terms of use (user agreement and privacy policy), enter your name and date of birth, create a password and respond to the verification email sent to you by LibreView.
- You can now log-in with your email and password – go to **STEP 4**

## Step 4 Uploading your reader data


When logged in, connect your Libre reader to your computer with the supplied USB cable (if you don't have one – you can pick one up at the diabetes department).

Click the green 'Upload' button **(C)** and follow the on-screen instructions to upload your Libre data.

**IMPORTANT:** You also need to link your LibreView account to the Western General account – go to **STEP 6** to do this now.

Now move to STEP 6.

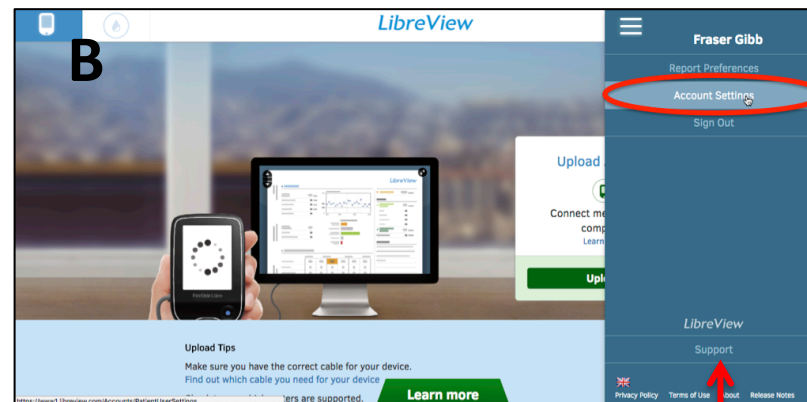
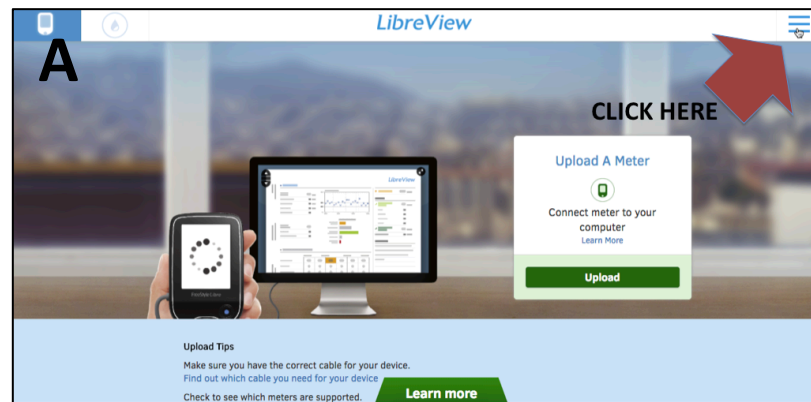
## Step 6 Linking your LibreView account to the Western General Diabetes Clinic

When logged in to your LibreView account click at the top right corner **(A)** and then open up 'Account Settings' **(B)**. Click the tab 'My practices' **(C)** and in the 'Link to a practice' box type in: **wghdiabetes** then click 'Add'.

This will link your Libre account to our Western General account.

If you are only using your phone to scan the Libre sensor this is all you need to do.

**IMPORTANT: If you are using a Libre reader (i.e. not using your phone to scan), upload your data as described in STEP 4.**



If you are having trouble getting any of this to work, click the 'support' option which has troubleshooting information
